

EARLY HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION

Except in extenuating circumstances, as determined by the Superintendent of Charlotte County Public Schools, students working towards a standard or advanced studies diploma will not be allowed to enroll in required high school English or Social Studies courses at grade levels other than those in which the subjects are normally required of students. The principal of the high school will be responsible for requiring that every student take coursework during both school semesters over a four year period in grades nine through twelve, unless an individual student will be over the age of eighteen upon completion of his/her senior year. In such instances, the principal may allow a student to take coursework for credit to allow for graduation during the school year in which the student will reach his eighteenth birthday.
