

COMMUNITY USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES

School facilities may be used as voting places in any primary, regular, or special election.

Community Partners of the Charlotte County School Board may be granted use of school facilities. Community Partners requesting the use of school facilities will be subject to the fee requirements established by the School Board. However, the Superintendent of Charlotte County Public Schools may waive the facility use fee to non-profit organizations that have established a partnership with the school system when the sole purpose of the activity at the school facility is to benefit Charlotte County Public School students and/or the general population of the community.

Individuals and organizations that have not established a business/education partnership with Charlotte County Public Schools will not be allowed to rent or use school facilities. Prior to being offered a partnership agreement each potential Business Partner must submit an application and be approved by the Charlotte County School Board.

Requests for the use of any school facilities shall be made to the School Principals. Principals will screen all requests and forward to the Superintendent of Charlotte County Public Schools or his/her designee the Applications for Facility Use and Indemnification Agreements received from Community Partners. Requests received from individuals or organizations that are not Community Partners will be denied at the school level.

The Superintendent/designee will have the authority to approve or deny all requests for use of facilities from Community Partners.
